PROGRAMMING COMMITTEE APPLICATION

1. Please give us your name, address, phone number, how long you've been a WORT listener, and your affiliation with WORT.
2. Describe your background in or experience with community radio, and your knowledge of radio in general. Feel free to include any knowledge of other radio stations, formats, etc. in your answer.
3. Explain the difference between community radio and public radio.
4. Name the programs you most enjoy on WORT, and explain why they appeal to you.
5. What do you feel is WORT's mission? How is it embodied by the current programming schedule?
6. Describe how you work in a group setting. How comfortable would you be working within a consensus-based decision-making process?
7. Describe how WORT serves the needs and interests of persons different than yourself.
8. Are there, in your opinion, communities unrepresented or underrepresented by our programming?
9. How are WORT's financial needs addressed by the current programming schedule? What general suggestions would you make to balance the need to improve fundraising while continuing to fulfill WORT's community mission?
10. When can you meet? How willing and capable are you to meet regularly and work outside of meetings?
